FACTS & FIGURES

- 5,800 undergraduate and 2,000 graduate students from 48 states and 47 countries
- Student body: 65% Virginia residents, 35% non-Virginia residents
- 23% of undergraduates are students of color, 11% are first-generation college students
- 4% of undergraduates are international students
- 95% retention rate for freshmen
- 99% of classes taught by faculty
- 12:1 student-to-faculty ratio (among the lowest of any state-supported university in the country)
- 40% of classes have fewer than 20 students, 86% have fewer than 40
- 2010-2011 tuition and fees, room and board: approximately \$21,000. for in-state, \$42,000. for out-of-state

- 38% admission rate for in-state students
- 27% admission rate for out-of-state students
- Incoming class size of approximately 1400
